Discussion will include exploration of the role of military forces, as well as the role of the United Nations and regional organizations, in the protection and promotion of International Human Rights and Humanitarian Law in International Peace Operations. Basic knowledge of International Humanitarian Law is required.

As the Workshop will strongly focus on case studies and practical exercises, enrolment in this Workshop is limited.
