

METTs are designed to provide an established resident NATO School Oberammergau course or “tailored” course/seminar which is conducted by a NATO School Oberammergau team at an offsite location upon a specific request of a governmental structure or an eligible organisation.

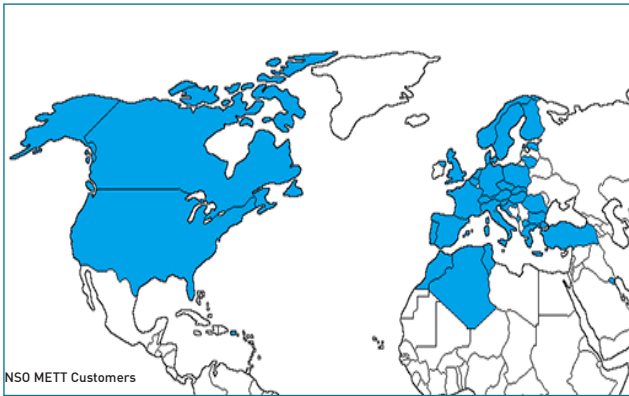
METTs are typically more cost effective for an organisation where there is a large group requiring training, thereby saving travel and per diem cost.

The School offers various different courses to Alliance members and Partners on subjects related to NATO’s policies, strategies, missions and operations.

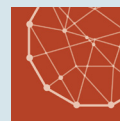
The academic curriculum compasses courses of instruction in 8 main disciplines, mostly one week in duration, in the fields of:

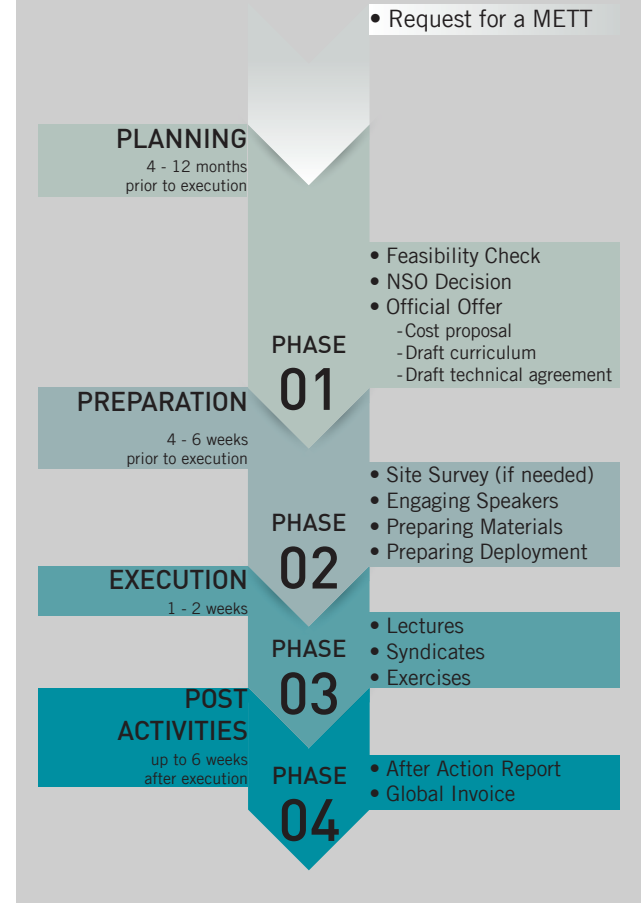
